

SAVED, WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

Therefore He is able also to save to the uttermost (completely, perfectly, finally, and for all time and eternity) those who come to God through Him, since He is always living to make petition to God and intercede with Him and intervene for them. Hebrews 7:25

For He says, In the time of favor (of an assured welcome) I have listened to and heeded your call, and I have helped you on the day of deliverance (the day of salvation). Behold, now is truly the time for a gracious welcome and acceptance [of you from God]; behold, now is the day of salvation! 2 Corinthians 6:2

Jesus is always living to make sure that you are saved to the uttermost. Jesus lives for you so that you are saved perfectly, completely, finally, and for all of eternity. And it is all yours today. Today is the day that you have all of this and now is your accepted time. But what does it mean to be saved? Lets look at the Greek word for saved: sozo, Strong's Concordance number 4982.

Definition

to save, keep safe and sound, to rescue from danger or destruction

one (from injury or peril)

to save a suffering one (from perishing), i.e. one suffering from disease, to make well, heal, restore to health

to preserve one who is in danger of destruction, to save or rescue

to save in the technical biblical sense

to deliver from the penalties of the Messianic judgment

to save from the evils which obstruct the reception of the Messianic deliverance

Now let's take the meaning of saved, or sozo, and utilize it with Hebrews 7:25 and 2 Corinthians 6:2.

Today Jesus lives to completely, perfectly, eternally, and to the uttermost keep you safe and sound, and rescue you from all danger. Jesus lives today to make you completely, perfectly, eternally, and to the uttermost well. Jesus lives to preserve you from destruction and to rescue you from anything that would hinder your complete salvation.

We have a High Priest in Jesus Who is very competent, and He has 100% track record of success. You cannot help but to have life and have it in abundance, because Jesus is on your side. He is greater in you than anything that is in this world.

The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance (to the full, till it overflows). John 10:19

Little children, you are of God [you belong to Him] and have [already] defeated and overcome them [the agents of the antichrist], because He

Who lives in you is greater (mightier) than he who is in the world. 1
John 4:4

Yet amid all these things we are more than conquerors and gain a
surpassing victory through Him Who loved us. Romans 8:37
